Health and Safety Policy Statement:

Rosebank Dancing School is strongly committed to encouraging members to take part and the health, well-being and safety of each individual is always our paramount concern. We recommend levels of dance training dependent on age and ability and expect our dancers to participate within these boundaries.

Health and Safety Policy:

To support our Health and Safety policy statement we are committed to the following duties:

- Undertake regular, recorded risk assessments of the dance school premises and all activities undertaken by the dance school.
- Create a safe environment by putting health and safety measures in place as identified by the assessment.
- Ensure that all members are given the appropriate level of dance training and regularly assessing individual ability dependant on age maturity and development.
- Ensure that all members are aware of, understand and adhere to the dance school's health and safety procedures.
- Ensure that emergency operation procedures are in place and known by all members.
- Provide access to adequate first aid facilities, telephone and qualified first aider at all times.
- Report any injuries or accidents sustained during any dance activity or whilst on the dance school premises it uses, using the appropriate procedures.
- Ensure that the implementation of the policy is reviewed regularly and monitored for effectiveness.

As a dance school member you have a duty to:

- Take reasonable care of your own health and safety and that of others who may be affected by what you do or do not do.
- Co-operate with the dance school's health and safety policies and procedures.
- Correctly use all equipment provided by the dance school.
- Not interfere with or misuse anything provided for your health, safety or welfare.
